

Important drug alert from the Department of Health

There is evidence of heroin being contaminated with the far stronger synthetic opioids Fentanyl and / or Carfentanyl.

Heroin user's are advised to use a test dose / taste the hit with any new supply.

We'd also like to remind you to keep your Naloxone / Prenoxad easily available.

If you don't currently have a Prenoxad pen these can be issued here, please ask a member of staff.



Unsure of what to do if someone is overdosing?

Pick up a leaflet, ask a staff member and attend the First Aid for Overdose training:
