

COVID-19 and STREET DRUGS

Due to travel restrictions, the purity of street drugs may decrease soon. This will mean that drugs bought on the street could be a lot more dangerous, especially if you have symptoms of COVID19.

Follow these simple tips to keep you and your friends as safe as possible:

- Buy from someone you trust
- If you're buying something different, research it first. Check erowid.org or pillreports.net
- If your drugs look unusual or smell weird, don't use them
- Test a small amount first if they do look ok, ideally by smoking some
- If you are feeling ill, you could overdose more easily. Use less than usual
- Never use alone
- To help stop the spread of COVID19, never share any equipment
- Have a prenoxad handy
